Long-Term Substitute Preschool Teacher, Full Time

Hampton Elementary School is seeking a highly motivated and enthusiastic individual to join our team as a Long-Term Substitute Preschool Teacher. This position will provide an exciting opportunity for someone passionate about early childhood education to make a positive impact on the growth and development of young children. The successful candidate will be responsible for creating a nurturing and engaging learning environment, fostering social-emotional development, and implementing developmentally appropriate activities.

Responsibilities:
